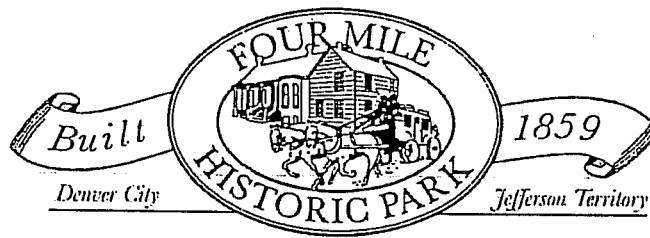

We look forward to seeing you on the 21st!

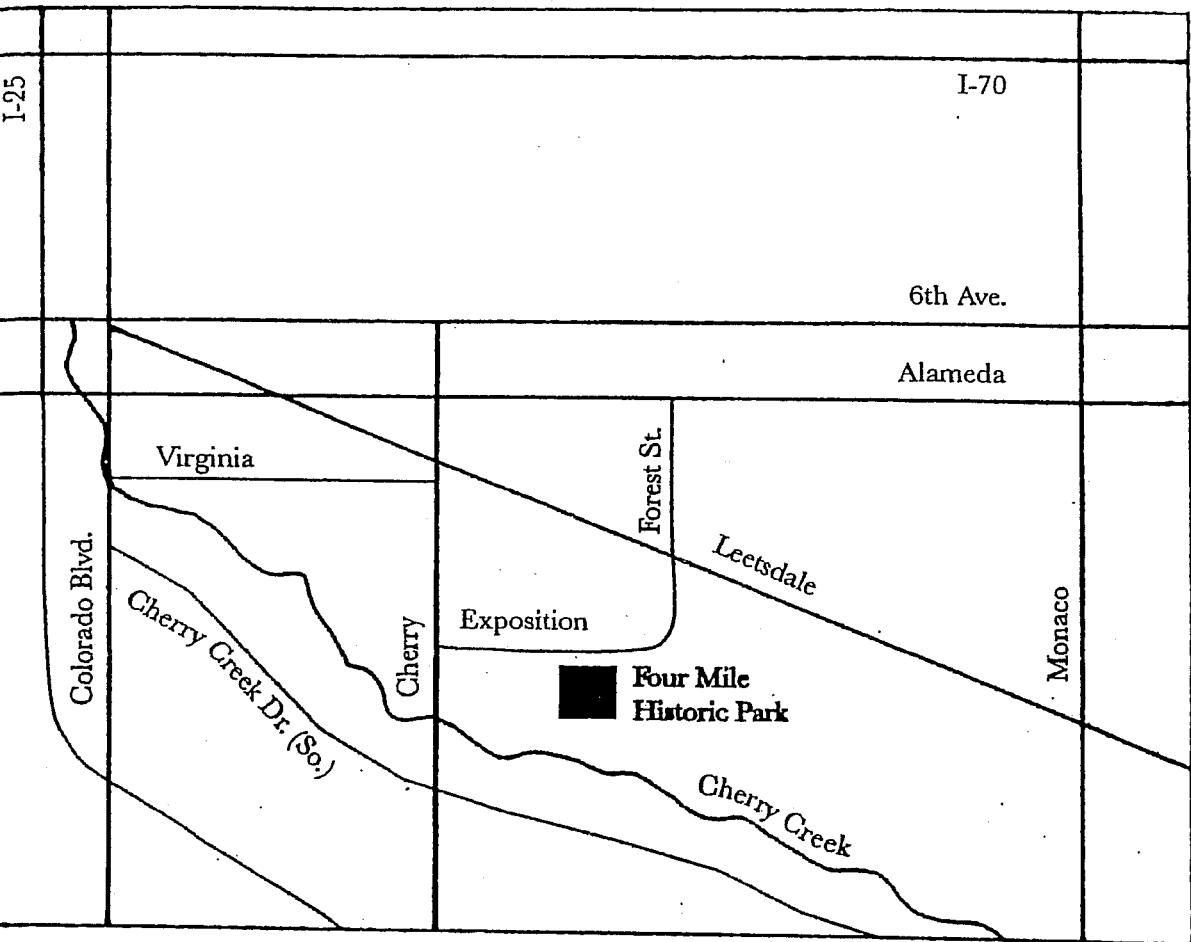
